COURSE DESCRIPTION

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who apply specialised knowledge and skills, together with experience in leadership and management, across a range of enterprise and industry contexts. Individuals at this level use initiative and judgement to plan and implement a range of leadership and management functions, with accountability for personal and team outcomes within broad parameters. They use cognitive and communication skills to identify, analyse and synthesise information from a variety of sources and transfer their knowledge to others, and creative or conceptual skills to express ideas and perspectives or respond to complex problems.

English Language Requirements

International Students must have a good command of written and spoken English International students who do not have English as first language will need to show that they are capable of completing the course successfully by meeting at least one of the following entry requirements:

An IELTS score (Academic Module) of 5.5 with no individual band score less than 5.0, or Certificate IV or Higher of AQF qualification or

PTE, with the minimum of overall 43 score (at least 36 score in each module)

Students with 5.0 bands will be considered if they have completed ELICOS program for minimum of 10 weeks.

American College in house English Placement Test for onshore applicants from Level 1 & 2 countries only, to be conducted under supervision of American College Staff.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) & Credit Transfer (CT)

Students may apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) by providing evidence that they have the required skills and knowledge in the specific areas of competency through work / industry experience and/or completed eligible assessments in an equivalent or higher qualification. Appropriate credit transfer may be granted to eligible students against each unit of competency on evidence to successful completion of the same unit in an equivalent or higher nationally endorsed qualification. Students with credit transfers or recognition of prior learning will finish the course in a shorter duration and are advised to consult appropriate authorities/bodies for applicable criteria if they are planning further study or stay in Australia.

Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of prior learning (RPL) is an assessment process that involves assessment of an individual's relevant prior learning (including formal, informal and non-formal learning) to determine the credit outcomes of an individual application for credit.
